

## Granite Care Guide

Granite is naturally resistant to scratches and stains when the materials is cared for in the correct manor. It is important to follow this guide to ensure the best possible protection of your stone worktops. By the routine sealing of the granite and use of the correct cleaning agents your granite worktops will remain in perfect condition.

### Daily Care

For the daily care of the worktops it is best to wipe them down using some warm water and soap with a microfibre cloth. Following this, ensure that the worktops are dried and no water is left standing on the worktops. Never use abrasive cleaners or chemical products on your granite tops. We would always recommend using Lithofin Easy Clean and Power Cleaner products as they are specifically designed to care for natural stone products. The regular cleaning of worktops helps eliminate any left-over particles that cold scratch or stain your granite.

### Sealing

All granite worktops that we sell come pre-sealed. Since granite is a porous material, sealing is the process of closing the pores inside of the granite to make it resistant to the absorption or stain-producing substances and particles. It is recommended to have you granite sealed at a least once a year.

### Never:

- Use abrasive chemicals on your worktops
- Cut directly on your worktops (always use a chopping board)
- Place hot pots or pans directly onto the worktops
- Put excessively heavy items onto the worktops
